

## **FIRE BAN LEVEL 1 (Excluding Pit Fire)**

1. THIS FIRE BAN SPECIFICALLY APPLIES TO ALL “OPEN FIRES”. “Open Fire” shall mean any Fire which is NOT A PIT FIRE and without limiting the generality of the foregoing shall include grass fires, brush fires, building fires, wood scrap fires, or any ground fires.
2. “PIT FIRE” shall mean a fire which is totally confined within a non-combustible structure or container that has the draft and smoke vents thereof covered with a heavy guage metal screen, spark arrestor, or is ventilated in such a manner as to preclude the escape of combustible materials (such as: chimneys, enclosed fire pits, or incinerators).
  - a. NO burning of painted wood, treated wood, plastic, garbage, etc. CLEAN WOOD ONLY.
  - b. Fire should not exceed containment (No bonfires)
  - c. Residents will be responsible for damages if fire gets out of control
  - d. Fires should never be left unattended
  - e. Resident shall keep fire suppression close by (water hose, fire extinguisher, etc.)
  - f. Do Not let fire smoke excessively
3. Portable Appliances which are fueled by propane or natural gas are currently not a part of the fire ban.

## **FIRE BAN LEVEL 2**

1. COMPLETE FIRE BAN – NO BURNING
2. Portable Appliances which are fueled by propane or natural gas are currently not a part of the fire ban.
