SPRING REMINDERS

<u>WATER METER READING</u> - Water meter readings are required between **April 26-30**, **June 26-30**, **and August 27-31**.

WATERING DAYS – See attached sheet and make note of your watering days.

<u>YARD & BACK ALLEY MAINTENANCE</u> – Please keep the area behind your lots and fences tidy, free of weeds, garbage and unobstructed by vehicles, etc. The boulevard in front of your property and the alleyway behind your property are your responsibility to keep clean and mowed. Refer to the Boulevard and Back Alley Policy for more information.

<u>SPRAYING</u> – The Village will be spraying weeds in back alleys/boulevards this Spring. If you do not wish to have your back alley/boulevard sprayed, please notify the Village Office by May 17th.

<u>SEASONAL TRAILER PARKING</u> – As per bylaw 2-2018: RV & Utility trailers are allowed to use the boulevards on a temporary basis (10 days) from May 1 till September 30. The trailer cannot extend onto the street or sidewalk, and slides and awnings must be retracted. Special circumstances may be granted by council, upon written request.

**Please keep in mind these policies are in effect to allow for safe passage on sidewalks for children and allow access to properties by emergency vehicles.

<u>PETS</u> – Please be a responsible pet owner and clean up after your pet

<u>PRUNING OF ELM TREES</u> – There is no pruning of elm trees between April 1 and August 31 unless you obtain municipal approval for a damaged tree, as stated in the "Saskatchewan Dutch Elm Disease Regulations"

STREET SWEEPING – Residents will be notified when a date for street sweeping has been set
