BYLAW NO. 5-2026

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXPROPRIATION OF LAND

The Council of the Village of Richmond, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Council of the Village of Richmond deems it necessary to acquire title to the land legally described as Blk/Par A Plan No 101397551 Extension 2 (Surface Parcel No. 147786418) (the "Land") for the purpose of recreation, namely the continued use, operation and maintenance of the Land as a public ball diamond, and park, being a service, facility or other thing that in the opinion of the Council is necessary and desirable for all or part of the municipality (The Municipalities Act, ss. 4(2)(b) and 4(3)).
2. The Council cannot acquire the Land by agreement with the owner. The registered owner, The Richmond Community Hall Co-operative Association Limited, was struck off the register under The Co-operatives Act, 1996 effective October 16, 2021, is inactive, and there is no person competent to contract with the Village for the sale and conveyance of the Land.
3. It shall be lawful for the Council of the Village of Richmond to expropriate the Land and to proceed in accordance with the provisions of The Municipal Expropriation Act, pursuant to section 3 of that Act.
4. This Bylaw comes into force on the passing of it.
